Communications and Maps

Communications

We will be communicating via D37 Channel 1 (weatherman) on handheld and base radios. You will need to have a relay person who can sit on top of a mountain and communicate with all checks and road crossings. It is imperative your relay person is located in the best place for communications and **NOT** located in camp. You may reach out to Robert Thompson for relay (714-299-1593 or KE6RKG@msn.com) or supply your own person. Please do not use riders' names over the radio. You may refer to them with their racing number, which will also be the identifier for that particular incident.

GPS & Maps

Please e-mail a GPS file of your event, usually the .kml file that you send to the BLM to obtain your permit to Ryan Wilson at _____ at least 1 month before your event. Mile markers will need to be included. Ryan will create maps from your file. If there are any changes made to your course that would affect the maps in locating a downed rider, you must contact Ryan immediately and forward the changes to him so he may update the maps. Please be as detailed as possible. If you will be referring to landmarks or named roads, they must be included on the maps. If its not on the map, we will not know where you are referring to.
