Hi All,

There hasn't been a lot going on since the last Referee's Corner column. The July Off Road meeting as well as the July Competition Committee meeting were canceled due in part to the summer break in off road events.

There was both an August Off Road meeting and Competition Committee meeting. Some new rules were proposed at the Competition Committee which if approved by the representatives at the next Off Road meeting will go into effect in January of 2017. I will post the approved new rules in the next newsletter.

The Lost Coyotes MC has received approval for Vintage, Revo. etc. classes at their Desert Scrambles race on 09-11-16. These will be along the same lines as the classes in the GP's. This is a one time event, which will not pay District 37 points. These classes will only do one loop of the Desert Scrambles. If there is enough interest in the event, these classes will be included in the Off Road schedule for 2017, at all the Desert Scrambles. For more information contact the Lost Coyotes.

The September Off Road meeting is when nominations for District 37 officers will be held. If you have considered running for a District 37 officers position, such as Steward, you should attend the meeting. Requirements for the positions can be found in the District 37 rule book, which is available on the District web site. Nominations will be open again at the October Off Road meeting, with the elections taking place that night.

One thing to keep in mind is attendance at the meetings. For example, if you are unable to attend the Competition Committee on the second Thursday of the month at 7:00 P.M. then the position is probably not for you. Every month there are items that need to be voted on, and proxy, or continuous phone in votes are not allowed.
